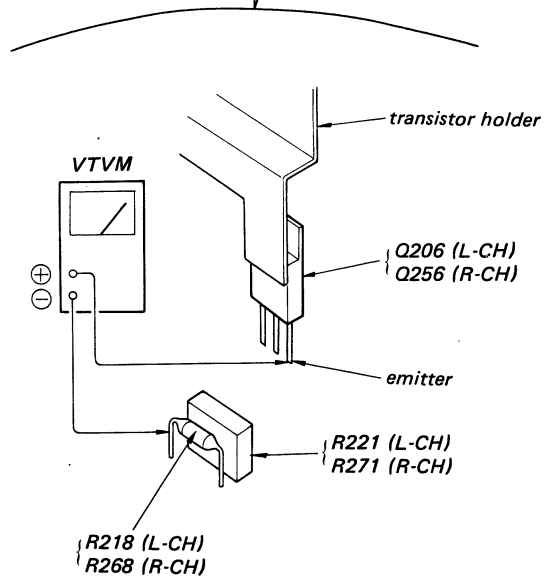
2. Adjust attenuator for 4V (2W) reading on VTVM.

2. With no input signal, adjust RV201 (L-CH) and RV251 (R-CH) for 10mV dc reading on VTVM.



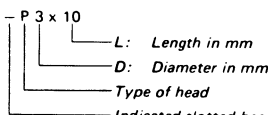
